Motion was made by Mr. Taylor & seconded by Mr. Majernik to approve the Treasurer's report for the month of January 2024. Unanimously approved.

Motion was made by Mr. Seitz & seconded by Ms. Roessler to approve the expenses for the month of January 2024. Unanimously approved.

Motion was made by Mr. Taylor & seconded by Mr. Purcell to approve the minutes of the January 8th, 2024 Council Meeting. Unanimously approved.

COUNCIL ACTIONS:

Motion was made by Mr. Majernik & seconded by Ms. Roessler to grant the waiver/modification request to Section 415 – Construction Details, in accordance with the Plum Borough Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance (the SALDO) to allow for a single-striped parking line construction standard at the southern portion of the project, being associated with the Presbyterian parking improvement, with the northern portion of the project to be a double-striped parking line construction standard to be shown on the Oakmont Country Club – Presbyterian Senior Care Golf Range and Site Improvements land development design drawings by the Civil and Environmental Consultants. Unanimously approved.

Motion was made by Mr. Majernik & seconded by Mr. Seitz to adopt Resolution 977-24, approving preliminary/final land development for the Oakmont Country Club Golf Range and Site Improvement project (SP-05-23)(Lot and Block 532-D-285), as recommended by the planning commission, with conditions outlined in the resolution. Unanimously approved.

Motion was made by Mr. Majernik & seconded by Mr. Taylor to adopt Ordinance 978-24, authorizing the establishment of three stop signs in Phase 1 of the Parkside Estates Housing Plan. Unanimously approved.

Motion was made by Mr. Majernik & seconded by Mr. Taylor to accept the Perrin-Ricciuti lot line revision as complete. Unanimously approved.

Motion was made by Mr. Seitz & seconded by Mr. Majernik to adopt Resolution 978-24, authorizing the destruction of certain municipal records in accordance with the Municipal Records Act. Unanimously approved.

Motion was made by Mr. Seitz & seconded by Mr. Schlauch to appoint myself and David Majernik as Delegate and Alternate Delegate to the Turtle Creek Valley COG Board. Unanimously approved.

Motion was made by Mr. Seitz & seconded by Mr. Taylor to approve a conditional offer of employment for Jason Saunders as Police Patrolman. Unanimously approved.

Motion was made by Mr. Seitz & seconded by Mr. Majernik to approve a conditional offer of employment for Halee Walek as Police Patrolwoman. Unanimously approved.

Motion was made by Mr. Seitz & seconded by Mr. Purcell to approve a conditional offer of employment for Luke Skledar as Police Patrolman. Unanimously approved.

Motion was made by Mr. Seitz & seconded by Ms. Roessler to appoint Andrew Novick to a 5-year term on the Zoning Hearing Board, ending on December 31st, 2028. Unanimously approved.

Motion was made by Mr. Seitz & seconded by Ms. Roessler to approve a lease with the Allegheny Foothills Historical Society for a room at the Plum Borough Library. The lease will expire at the end of 2024. Unanimously approved.

Motion was made by Ms. Roessler & seconded by Mr. Purcell to authorize the advertisement of an ordinance revising the Civil Service Regulations. Unanimously approved.

Motion was made by Ms. Roessler & seconded by Mr. Majernik to adopt Resolution 979-24, amending Resolution 900-21, approving the intra-municipal transfer of Liquor License #R-16698 to Sheetz Inc at 950 Presque Isle Drive. Unanimously approved.

Motion was made by Mr. Taylor & seconded by Mr. Schlauch to approve the purchase of a precast restroom from CXT, Inc in the amount of \$122,670.00. Unanimously approved.
